During this period Greater Anglia were introducing their new fleet of Stadler Class 755 bi-mode trains and so we shall see the changeover to the new trains from the cascaded rolling stock that had long served the line including Class 153, 156 and 170 units and the loco-hauled short sets. We will also take to the skies to see the Wherry Lines from a different perspective with a series of aerial images.
